NEW BUSINESS: Ordinance No. 345- Amending the zoning ordinance definition of lot and creating requirements for

lots without public road frontage. The planning members discussed the proposed amendment with their proposed changes. (See Attached) On a motion by Charles Zitnick 2nd by Jim McCoy to recommend approval with the corrections under Section 3, section 418 Lot frontage- a. insert between lots and must [and existing lots for which a change is proposed requiring township approval]. Section418 b.1 Insert between Lots and which [without any buildings] and add a definition in Section 201 for nature reserve. b.2. strike a private driveway access and replace with [an access drive]. b.2.a strike cartway and replace with [access drive]. b.2.b. insert between document and acceptable [and maintenance agreement]. b.2.c strike driveway and replace with [access drive],insert the word [the] before township and strike residential and replace with [buildings]. Also would like to point out the number of lots per ROW is not addressed or the maximum length of ROW. Motion carried. The vote recorded 4-0.

OTHER BUSINESS: Pat McCoy -questioned why Mill Wood Homes did not come before the planning board for their

request to exceed the maximum grade of a driveway. It was explained Cease & Desist Orders are addressed by the Board of Supervisors.
